Tax Assistance

Volunteers can preform minor home repair and outdoor yard work. Volunteers may assist with minor carpentry, installation of grab bars, other small repairs for the safety of the home, help with raking leaves,, pulling weeds, etc. Volunteers complete local, state, and federal income tax forms for individuals aged 60 and over at no charge. Training is required. A commitment during tax season (February-Mid-April) is needed.







The Adams County Office for Aging is governed by a Board of Directors, appointed to a three-year term. The Board meets monthly on the fourth Thursday. The Advisory Council meet monthly on the third Wednesday to give advice on programs and services.
